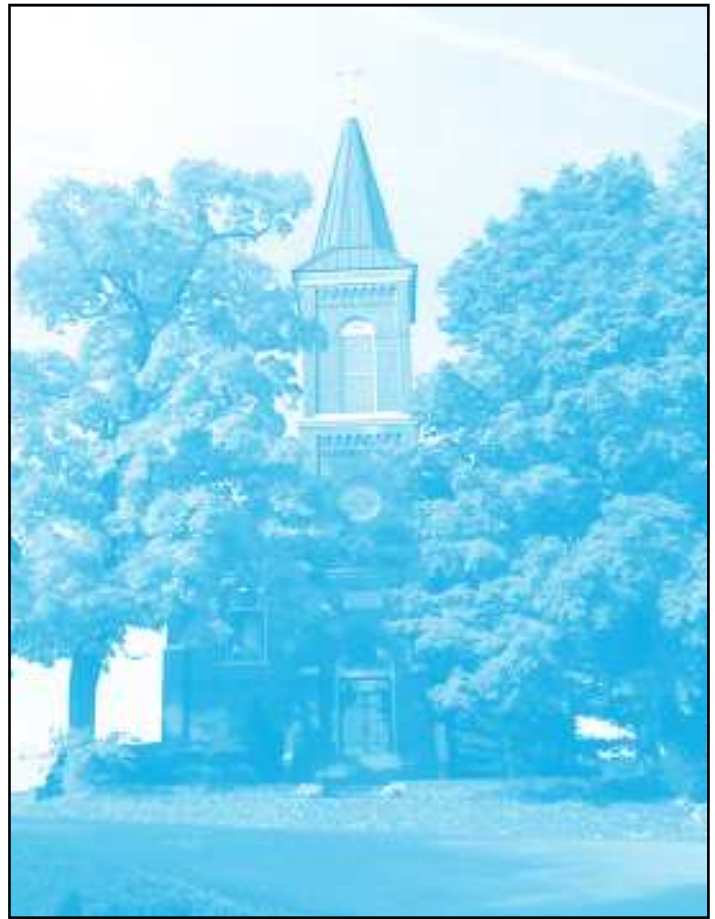

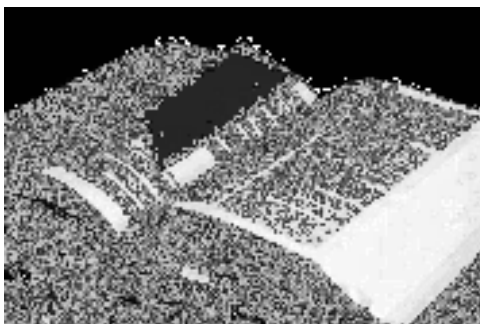

Welcome to Father Tobias Colgan from St. Meinrad. Today is St. Meinrad Sunday throughout the Diocese of Evansville. Father Tobias will speak to us about the work and mission of St. Meinrad. As in the past many years you will receive a letter this week from Archabbot Justin DuVall asking for your support both through your prayers and financially, if you are able. I know you will again be generous. St. Meinrad, of course, educates young men for the priesthood, but also has theology courses for anyone working in the mission of the Church or anyone wanting to know more about the Catholic Church teachings.

The message is the best way for the bishop to communicate with all the people of the diocese. Use that envelope and drop in the collection basket before the end of February. Let's build up our Message subscription list.

Did you see in the Message a few issues back that the Groundbreaking at St. Clement was one of the top news stories of the year 2009? Great !!

Today and next weekend will be Sign-Up Sunday for Session 1 of Year 3 of the "Why Catholic?" Program. This year's theme is "Catholic Moral Teaching: The Beatitudes and the Commandments." This should be a very valuable session for all of us, especially when we are faced so much in modern society with so many moral decisions.
