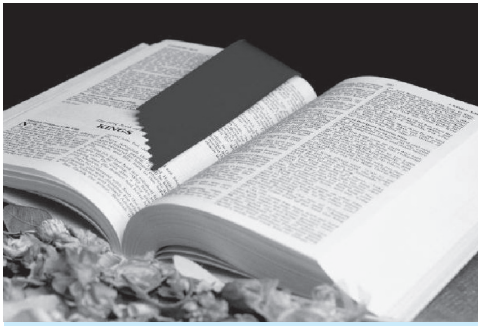

Dear Parishioners,

As we honor the Trinity today on this Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, let's briefly center on the Sign of the Cross that we make at the beginning and end of all our prayers.

It is impossible to understand the theology of the Trinity, because it deals with the essential nature of God Himself, and it is impossible to understand the mystery of God. But we deal with Trinity everyday in a very practical way – by making the Sign of the Cross. Christ died on the cross for our salvation. So the Cross of Christ is a real symbol of that salvation. We hang that cross in church and in our homes as a symbol of the loving salvation. We go a deeper step and sign ourselves with that cross often to sanctify ourselves and to sanctify our words and deeds. We are sacred human beings because we have been redeemed by that cross of Christ.

To show that sacredness we are signed with that cross 1) in the sacraments of baptism, confirmation and anointing of the sick, 2) we begin the Mass with the Sign of the Cross and are sent forth from the Mass with the blessing of the priest – we sign ourselves with that cross to live that Eucharist throughout the week, and 3) we begin and end all prayer with that same Sign of the Cross.

Is that Sign of the Cross made thoughtfully enough to make real and practical its rightful meaning? Is it made slowly enough to let us realize what we are really doing? Do we say each word distinctly? Our faith will be more alive when we make the Sign of the Cross thoughtfully and slowly.
